

# Pedestrian Railway Crossings

Instructions on how to use your new swing gate railway crossing

**Always use the pedestrian railway crossing to cross the tracks.**

**Stay on the path. Stay alert. Stay safe.**

The new swing gate pedestrian railway crossings are activated by a sensor on the tracks and have a safety zone with an emergency exit gate.



When a train is approaching, bells sound, the red pedestrian light will come on and the crossing gate will automatically swing closed. Stay behind the swing gate and wait until it is fully open before crossing.



If you have already started crossing when the swing gates close, *do not panic*, finish crossing and enter the safety zone to the side of the gate on the other side of the tracks.



Once you are in the safety zone, push the gate release button to open the exit gate out of the safety zone. If there is no button then the gate can just be pushed open to exit.



**AVOID A \$400 FINE!**

*Always* use the pedestrian railway crossing to cross the tracks.
